PRODUCT:

Compac #118 General Purpose 1.5 Mil Aluminum Foil Tape with Acrylic Adhesive.

PRINCIPAL USES:

Compac #118 aluminum foil tape is used on insulation board and batts to maintain the integrity of the vapor barrier. Due to the conformity of dead soft foil, Compac #118 can be used on irregular and curved surfaces.

FEATURES/BENEFITS:

Compac #118 features an aggressive acrylic adhesive system which is all-temperature rated to provide service temperatures of -25°F (-32°C) to 250°F (121°C) and application temperatures of 10°F (-12°C) to 150°F

TECHNICAL DATA:
